New County Budget sees increase in revenues

County Administrator Mike Merrill formally presented the \$3.95 billion 2014-15 budget to county commissioners Wednesday, opening a summer-long discussion about the spending plan that begins Oct. 1. There will be a workshop June 25 and a public hearing July 17, before the commission will vote on the finalized budget twice in September.
