Hillsborough Commissioners unveil plan for Entrepreneur Collaborative Center

Hillsborough County commissioners moved forward with a plan to create a new business resource center to help entrepreneurs and startups. The new center, Commissioner Sandy Murman said, is an “earth shaking proposal” to foment economic development.

Commissioners approve protocol for removal and disposal of dead animals

Hillsborough County Commissioners approved the proposed changes to how the county removes and disposes of dead animals. Protocol now includes identification of deceased pets, sensitive notification of owners, and sensitivity training. Pet Resources, Code Enforcement and Public Works will partner in this much needed service.
