Commission okays five-year plan to prevent violence

In Hillsborough County, the specifics of a plan to combat violence have yet to take shape, but county commissioners agree one is needed. Thursday, they approved an ambitious but vague five-year program that will try to combat violent crime through preventive measures, modeled on similar plans across the country. Commissioners Les Miller and Sandy Murman, while ultimately voting in favor, asked for more details on what the collaborative will do and how its impact will be measured.

Commissioners ask Internal Auditor to review Civil Service Board public information

Hillsborough commissioners asked the County Internal Auditor to look at the current public information available on the County Civil Service Board to determine if there is enough documentation to conduct an audit of the organization. The BOCC also directed county staff to add to its legislative agenda the need for a bill to require an annual audit of the CSB.

Hillsborough County will host all-inclusive online calendar of events

The Board approved the proposal from staff to develop and implement a Countywide Online Calendar which would be web-based and include County events, as well as those from the cities of Plant City, Tampa and Temple Terrace and neighborhood associations. Staff recommended the use of an online calendar application that can best provide multiple layers of events, is mobile friendly and fully customizable.
