Morgan found himself among the nearly 1.3 million young people across the United States who are classified as "unaccompanied youths" and can't get foster care because they chose to leave a situation rather than be removed by social services.

When it came to population growth last year, cities in central Florida grew by stadiums. Metro Orlando grew by 60,000 residents last year. The Tampa area grew last year by 51,000 residents, more than the number of fans who can fit into Tropicana Field, where the city's Tampa Bay Rays play baseball. Growth from mid-2017 to mid-2018 propelled these two metropolises into the top tier of the nation's fastest growing metro areas, according to figures released Thursday by the U.S. Census Bureau.

Midtown Tampa has confirmed that a 226-room hotel will share two of Marriott International Inc.'s millennial-g geared flags. Bromley Cos., the New York-based developer of Midtown, said that 115 rooms will be branded with the Element flag — the city's first Element hotel, which has a "spacious, laid-back" vibe, according to Bromley. The other 111 rooms will have the Aloft flag.
