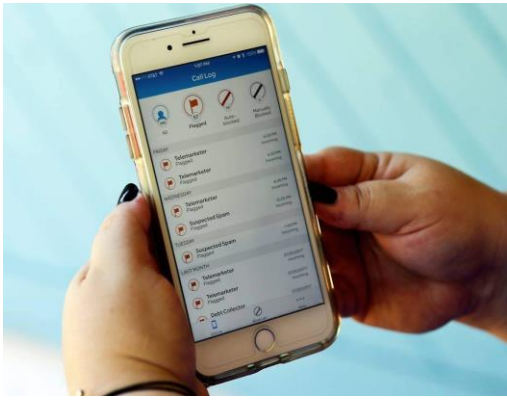
[County Awards More than \\$205,000 in College Scholarships](#)

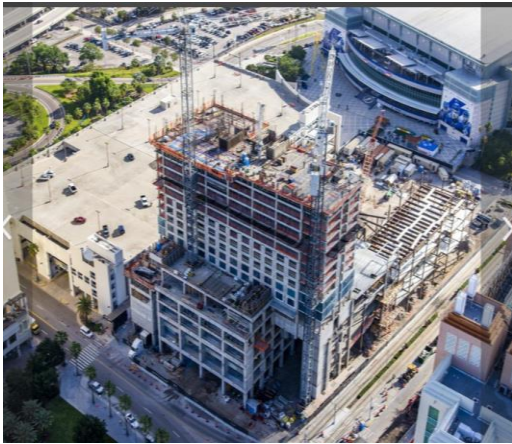
[10 Years of Change: USF grows from commuter school to preeminent and proud](#)

Getting tons of robocalls, Tampa Bay? You're not alone. Florida ranks as a Top 10 state. At the current escalating rate, if 60 billion robocalls are made in 2019, it will be double the number made in 2016. Four Florida cities ranked in the top 20 for robocalls received in May, with Tampa 18th at 48 million.

Grant Will Help Attract Technology-Focused Industries

The Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners approved a grant of up to \$5.3 million over three years to assist in the operation of the [University of South Florida Institute of Applied Engineering](#) that will enhance local scientific research and educational opportunities, and attract new technology-focused industries and work force talent to the Hillsborough County area.

Empowerment Programs Create Paths to Self-Sufficiency

The Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners accepted a \$1.6 million Community Service Block Grant to fund family empowerment, [education empowerment](#), and youth empowerment programs and partnerships that will assist low-income residents in reaching self-sufficiency.

Additional Funds Help Residents Avoid Electricity Shutoffs

The Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners approved a modification that adds \$4.89 million to the [Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program](#) (LIHEAP) that will assist an additional 11,800 households avoid electricity shutoffs through energy assistance payments.
