County Office Closings - Thanksgiving

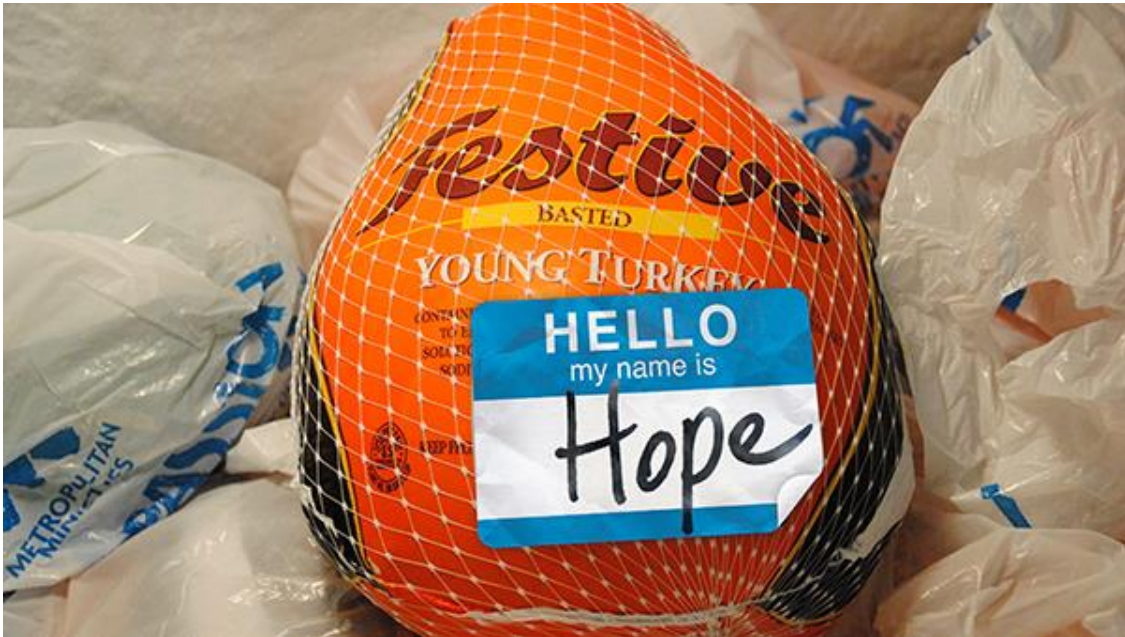

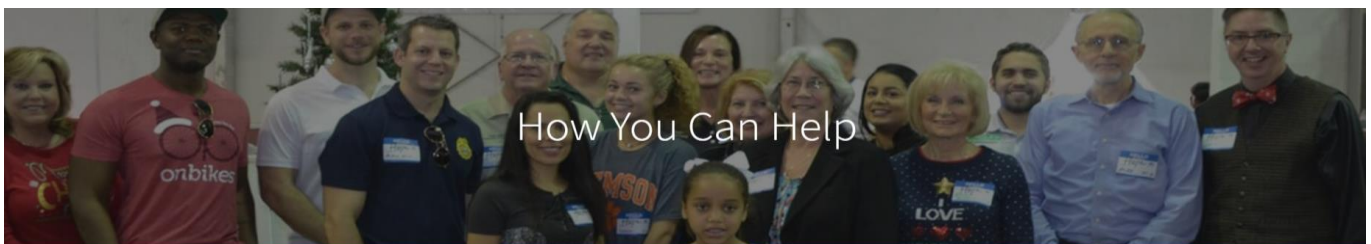
